Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus under Article 226 of Constitution of India declaring the acts of the respondents particularly 5th respondent-Tahsildar, with the aid of 6th respondent in insisting petitioners to vacate from their landed property of Ac. 1-97½ cents, bearing Survey No.803/5 of Rudrakotarajugudem Village, T.Narasapuram Mandal, Eluru District by issuing proceedings. Dated 30.07.2024 unilaterally while the civil suit in OS.No.65/2021 filed by 7th respondent against petitioners for declaration of title and possession of subject property and other civil proceedings are pending on the file of Civil Judge, Junior Division, Chintalapudi as illegal, irregular, irrational, violative of principles of natural justice, without jurisdiction and violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere in any manner with petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of their said land in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere in any manner with petitioners' possession and enjoyment over their land with cashew fruit bearing trees in respect of subject land to an extent of Ac. 1-97½ cents, bearing Survey No.803/5 of Rudrakotarajugudem Village, T.Narasapuram Mandal, Eluru District, which stands in the name of

petitioners' father Mahalaksh mudu, pending disposal of the Writ Petition No. 22266 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri.C.Venkaiah Advocate for the Petitioners, Government Pleader for Revenue for Respondent Nos.1 to 5 and Government Pleader for Home for Respondent No.6, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

“Heard Sri C.Venkaiah, learned Counsel for the Petitioners and Sri Arjun Chowdary, learned Assistant Government Pleader.

2. At the request of the learned Counsel for the Respondents (Official and Unofficial), let Counter Affidavit be filed within four weeks. Two weeks thereafter for filing Rejoinder, if any.

3. Post on 31.12.2024.

4. Interim Order granted earlier shall stand extended until the next listing.”
