Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including the arrest of the petitioners in F.I.R. No. 2 of 2026 on the file of Sanjamala Police Station, Nandyal District, Pending disposal of CRIMINAL PETITION 7246 of 2026, on the file of the High Court

The Court made the following: ORDER

- "1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.**
- 2. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of the respondent No.1-State.**
- 3. Issue notice to the unofficial respondent No.2.**
- 4. Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to the unofficial respondent No.2 through Speed Post with acknowledgement due/Email/WhatsApp, in accordance with ROC.No.165/2021-CPS, dated 17.04.2023, and file proof of service in the Registry.**
- 5. Learned counsel for the petitioners asserts that Petitioner Nos.1 and 2 (A2 and A3) are the parents of Accused No.1, and petitioner No.3**

(A4) is the brother of Accused No.1, and they are no way nexus with the alleged matrimonial misunderstandings between Accused No.1 and respondent No.2. Learned counsel further asserts that they have been roped into the instant case merely on account of their relationship with Respondent No.2. He further submits that petitioner Nos.1 and 2 (A2 and A3) are suffering with ailments.

6. On the other hand, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that, in view of the allegations leveled against the petitioners, the police are contemplating taking action under Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, against the petitioners, to the extent applicable, and seeks time to get instructions.

7. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, respondent-police are directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners, for a period of two (02) weeks only.
