District under the guise that the same is required for allotment of house sites to the Weaker Section without adhering to due process of law as arbitrary, illegal, colorable exercise of power, contrary to the provision The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 and well established legal principles apart from being volatile of the fundamental and Constitutional rights guaranteed to the petitioners under Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the petitioners rights over the land in an extent of extent of Ac 0.75 cents in Sy.No.131-2, Ac 0.37 cents in Sy.No.131/2A and Ac.0.38 cents in Sy.No.131/2G of Rameswaram Village fields , H/o Somulavaripalli, Proddatur Mandal, Y.S.R. District without adhering to due process of law and pass

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and Learned Assistant Government Pleader for the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that it is clearly stated in the counter affidavit that, after regularization, an award was passed to the subject lands vide Award Ref.No. G3/2465/2020 dated 08.04.2020. In which, an amount of Rs.20,72,813/- was paid to the 1st petitioner for the lands in Sy.No.131/2G to an extent of Ac.0.38 Cents and in Sy.No.131/2F to an extent of Ac.0.37 cents and an amount of Rs. 20,72,812/- was paid to the 2nd petitioner for the lands in Sy.No.131/2D to an extent of Ac.0.375 cents and in Sy.No.131/2F to an extent of Ac.0.375 cents, as the petitioners have purchased the lands through pending Documents bearing Nos.44/19 and 45/19.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are not in contact with him and requested to grant liberty for filing a fresh Writ Petition if their grievance is not redressed.

In view of the above, the Writ Petition is disposed of. However, it is open to the petitioners to file a fresh Writ Petition, if they are so advised. No costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
