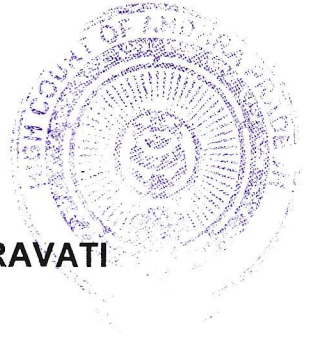

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of Resumption Order in Proceedings Roc.No.09/2019/A, dt. 30.07.2025 passed by the 4th respondent and consequently direct the respondents 2 to 5 not to interfere with petitioner's possession over her agricultural landed property covered thereby, pending disposal of WP No.23744 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER:

"Earlier, present petitioner preferred W.P.No.13146 of 2020 questioning the resumption orders vide Roc.No.09/2019(A), dated 06.06.2020, and a Coordinate Bench of this Court has granted status quo. Thereafter, petitioner has submitted explanation. It is stated that without considering the grievance of the petitioner in proper perspective, the present impugned rejection order dated 30.07.2025 was passed.

The said rejection order is assailed on the ground that the respondent authorities have not considered the explanation offered by the petitioner, in proper perspective and the petitioner is landless poor person. Hence, prayed to set aside the impugned proceedings.

Learned State counsel would submit that after considering all the contentions raised by the petitioner, the present impugned order came to be passed. However, sought further time to file counter-affidavit.

On perusal of the impugned proceedings, it appears that the 4th respondent-Tahsildar has not addressed the contention raised by writ petitioner. Hence, there shall be interim direction as prayed for, for a period of four (04) weeks."
