WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri CH Dhanamjaya presented this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to Quash the proceedings as against Petitioners/Accused No.2 and 3 in Cr.No.103 of 2020 on the file of Disha Women PS, Rajamahendravaram. and CC No.3289 OF 2021 before Hon'ble IV Additional Judicial First-Class Magistrate, Rajamahendravaram for the alleged offences under Sections 498-A, 354(A)(2) R/w. 34 of IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri CH Dhanamjaya Advocate for the Petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.
