WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI P L RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 herein in not taking any steps to re-structure the loan a/c No. No.612-03 which was declared as NPA, through Revival and Rehabilitation and to provide working capital deleting the loan account from NPA and to regularize the same inspite of the written representation dt. 10-9-2024 followed by personal visits, as being illegal, arbitrary, unjust and

unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 herein to re-structure the loan by deleting the loan account from NPA duly regularizing the same by considering the representation dt. 10-9- 2024;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P L RAO Advocate for the Petitioner and of DEPUTY SOLICITOR GENERAL for the Respondent No.1 and of SMT. V.DYUMANI, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.2 & 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
