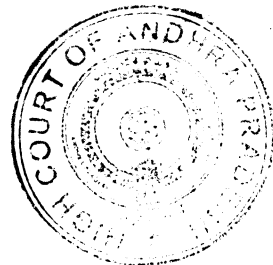

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in trying to dispossess the petitioners from the land in an extent of Ac.2.13 Cts in Sy.No.16/2 of Loddabadra Village, Palasa Mandal, Srikakulam District, without following due process of law, as arbitrary, illegal, in violation of Article 14 and 300 A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondents not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the land in an extent of Ac.2.13 Cts in Sy.No.16/2 Loddabadhra Village, Palasa Mandal, Srikakulam District.

IA NO: 1 OF 2019:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the land in an extent of Ac.2.13 Cts in Sy.No.16/2 Loddabadhra Village, Palasa Mandal, Srikakulam District, pending disposal of the WP 21526 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.
