ORDER:

“Pursuant to the orders passed by this Court on 31.08.2026 in I.A.No.1 of 2026, 1st defendant had deposited an amount of USD 14,07,225/- into the account of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court. To that effect, the Registrar (Judicial) has submitted a report today at about 04.00 pm stating that the aforesaid amount has been received. The said report is taken on file.
