Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased toto issue a writ in the nature of a writ of mandamus or any other

appropriate writ, direction, order or orders declaring the action of the 3rd respondent issued the endorsement vide Roc NO.A138/2019 dt.17-12-2019 stating that his father late K.Subbaiah S/o Mangaiah was not granted patta and the revenue records produced by me petitioner is fabricated one by unilaterally observea without considered the same with reference to the assignment patta vide DKT No.331/10/77 dt.24-01-1968 with regard to the Sy.No.29/3 admeasuring 0-74 cents and Sy.No.29/4 admeasuring 2-65 cents total Ac.3- 39 cents situated at Kurakalava village accounts, Renigunta Mandal, Chittoor District, which are in petitioner's exclusive peaceful possession and enjoyment of the same by way of inheritance as wholly arbitrary, illegal, without jurisdiction and void and violated the principles of natural justice and affected the petitioner's rights guaranteed under article 14, 19(1)(g) and 300(A) of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the endorsement vide Roc NO. NO.A138/2019 dt.17-12-2019 passed by the 3rd respondent herein by incorporate his name in the entire revenue records in place of his father late K.Subbaiah with reference to the above said lands

The Court made the following ORDER:

Perused the records as well as the original pattas issued to the petitioners.

2. The writ petition is filed questioning the endorsement issued *vide* Roc.No.A138/2019, dated 17.12.2019, by the 3rd respondent.

3. On 27.01.2020, this Court directed the respondents not to dispossess the petitioners from the disputed land and the same has been extended from time to time. Since the disputed questions of facts are involved in the case with regard to pattas issued by the respondents, the petitioners are directed to file a suit before the competent civil Court along with an application seeking interim injunction, within four (4) weeks from today.

Till such time, the interim order of *status-quo* shall be continued.

4. With this observation, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
