	09.09.2026	<u>Dr.YLR,J</u> Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. This Court, in CrI.P.No.7151 of 2026 on 24.08.2026, passed the following order: <i>"It appears that notices were exchanged prior to the institution of the suit by the accused against the de-facto complainant in O.S.No.92 of 2026 on the file of the learned III Additional District Judge, Nellore.</i> <i>Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the Investigating Officer is directed not to take any coercive steps against the Petitioners until the next date of hearing.</i> <i>However, the Petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 31.08.2026 at 10:00 A.M. and continue to appear before the Investigating Officer until further instructions.</i> <i>The Investigating Officer is directed to conduct the investigation in accordance with law, and the Petitioners shall cooperate with the investigation.</i> <i>The de-facto complainant is not shown as Respondent No.2 in this case.</i> <i>The de-facto complainant is impleaded as respondent No.2 in the present case as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Jagjeet Singh and others v. Ashish Mishra.</i> <i>The Registry is directed to carry out the necessary amendments.</i> <i>Issue notice to respondent No.2.</i> <i>The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.</i> <i>Post on 15.09.2026."</i> In view of the above, the Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 17.09.2026 at 10.00 AM and shall continue to appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required, until further instructions are issued by the Investigating Officer.	..Contd..

The Investigating Officer is directed to conduct the investigation in accordance with law, but shall not arrest the Petitioner until the next date of hearing. The Petitioner shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer in the course of investigation.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2

The counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on the Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Post this matter along with Crl.P.No.7151 of 2026.
