1.	12.09.2025	<u>RNT,J</u> O.S.No.134 of 2011, on the file of the Principal Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial 1st Class Magistrate, Gudivada, was filed by the plaintiff/1st respondent herein seeking injunction and was dismissed on 06.01.2022. 2. Aggrieved by the said order dated 06.01.2022, the plaintiff preferred A.S.No.17 of 2022. In the said appeal, the petitioner/appellant filed I.A.No.47 of 2025 under Order 41 Rule 27 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking permission to receive certain documents as additional evidence and to mark the same as exhibits on her behalf. The present petitioner, who was the defendant in the original suit, filed objections thereto. The learned Appellate	(contd.)

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		Court allowed the application by order dated 24.07.202, and permitted to file the documents as additional evidence. 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned order dated 24.07.2025 suffers from illegality, inasmuch as no reasons have been recorded to justify the admissibility of the additional documents. He submits that, without considering or recording how and why such documents were relevant and necessary for the adjudication of the appeal, the learned Appellate Court has directly allowed the application.
