Petition under Section 389(1) of Cr.P.C / 430(1) of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to enlarge the petitioner/ accused No.6 by suspending the sentence dated 23.09.2024 Passed in SC No.74/2022 on the file of the Principal District Judge, Ananthapuramu for treatment in Super Specialty Hospital, Pending disposal of CRLA No. 691 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with,

made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER

Appellant No.5 / accused No.6 filed the present application under Section 431 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') seeking to enlarge him on bail for a limited period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner/appellant No.5/accused No.6 is suffering from ill-health and he suffered blood vomiting. Petitioner/appellant No.5/accused No.6 was admitted in RIMS Hospital, Kadapa, as such the learned counsel requests this Court to enlarge the petitioner/appellant No.5/accused No.6, on bail.

On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor produced written instructions dated 06.12.2025, submitted by the Superintendent of Jails, Central Prison, Kadapa, along with Medical Certificate furnished by the Civil Assistant Surgeon, Central Prison, Kadapa, wherein it was stated that the petitioner has suffered brain stroke on 18.11.2025 and that he is also suffering from acute ischemic, "Cerebrovascular Accident Upper Motor Neuron Facial palsy with Broca's Aphasia". As of now he is taking treatment in RIMS Hospital, Kadapa.

In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, we are inclined to grant interim bail to the petitioner/appellant No.5/accused No.6, for a period of two months enabling him to take treatment.

Accordingly the petitioner/appellant No.5/accused No.6 is enlarged on bail for a period of two months from 15.12.2025 to 16.02.2026, on his furnishing personal bond for Rs.10,000/- with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Jails, Central Prison, Kadapa. The petitioner/appellant No.5/accused No.6 is directed to surrender before the Superintendent of Jails, Central Prison, Kadapa, by 5:00 p.m. on 16.02.2026.

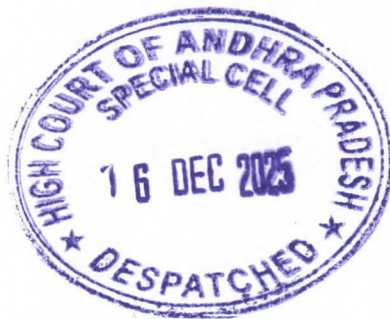
