This Criminal Revision Case has been filed under Sections 438 and 442 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity 'the BNSS') seeking to challenge the Judgment, dated 13.09.2022 passed in Crl.A.No.498 of 2016 on the file of the learned V Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for Trial of Offences Against Women, Guntur, confirming the Judgment of conviction and sentence of the petitioner passed by the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Sattenapalli in C.C.No.32 of 2015, dated 16.09.2016.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel for the respondent No.2.

3. The petitioner and respondent No.2 are present. They have compromised the matter. They filed I.A.Nos.1 and 2 of 2026 along with joint memo and affidavits, which have been countersigned by the learned counsel for both sides.

4. The respondent No.2 is permitted to compromise the matter with the petitioner under Section 320(6) of Criminal Procedure Code (for short 'the Cr.P.C.'), read with Section 147 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

5. In that view of the matter, I.A.Nos.1 and 2 of 2026 are allowed in terms of the compromise recorded. Consequently, the Criminal Revision Case is allowed in terms of compromise. The petitioner is directed to pay an amount of Rs.25,000/- towards costs, to the High Court Legal Services Committee by 20.04.2026. Learned counsel for the petitioner placed on record memo along with the receipt dated 20.04.2026 to show the payment of costs of Rs.25,000/- to the High Court Legal Services Committee.

6. Accordingly, the Judgments in C.C.No.32 of 2015, dated 16.09.2016 on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge, Sattenapalli and in Crl.A.No.498 of 2016, dated 13.09.2022 on the file of V Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for Trial of Offences Against Women, Guntur are hereby set aside. Accordingly, the petitioner is acquitted.

Consequently, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
