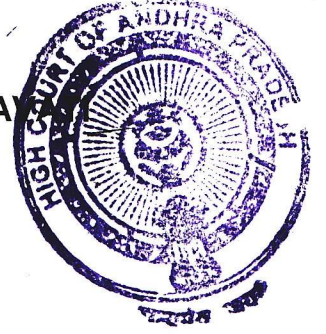

WHEREAS the Petitioners have presented under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971, above case through their counsel Sri M.Pitchaiah, praying that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to punish the respondents herein for willful disobedience of the orders in W.P.No.27686 of 2021, dated 02.01.2025;

WHEREAS the said case coming on for orders as to admission on this day and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein and

upon hearing the arguments of Sri M.Pitchaiah, Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issuance of Notice to the respondents, to show cause as to why in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support thereof, the said case should not be admitted.

The Court further made the following ORDER:

“Sri Geethak, learned counsel representing Sri M.Pitchaiah, learned Counsel for the petitioners submitted that this Court on 02.01.2025, disposed of W.P.No.27686 of 2021 directing the authorities not to interfere with the property of the petitioners’ except under due process of law. Despite such direction, the petitioners’ property has been put in prohibitory list under Section 22A of the Registration Act, 1908. He further submitted that including the property in prohibitory list amounts to interference with the property of the petitioners, as such, it amounts to be contempt and the respondent/s are liable to be punished.
