List after two (02) weeks.”

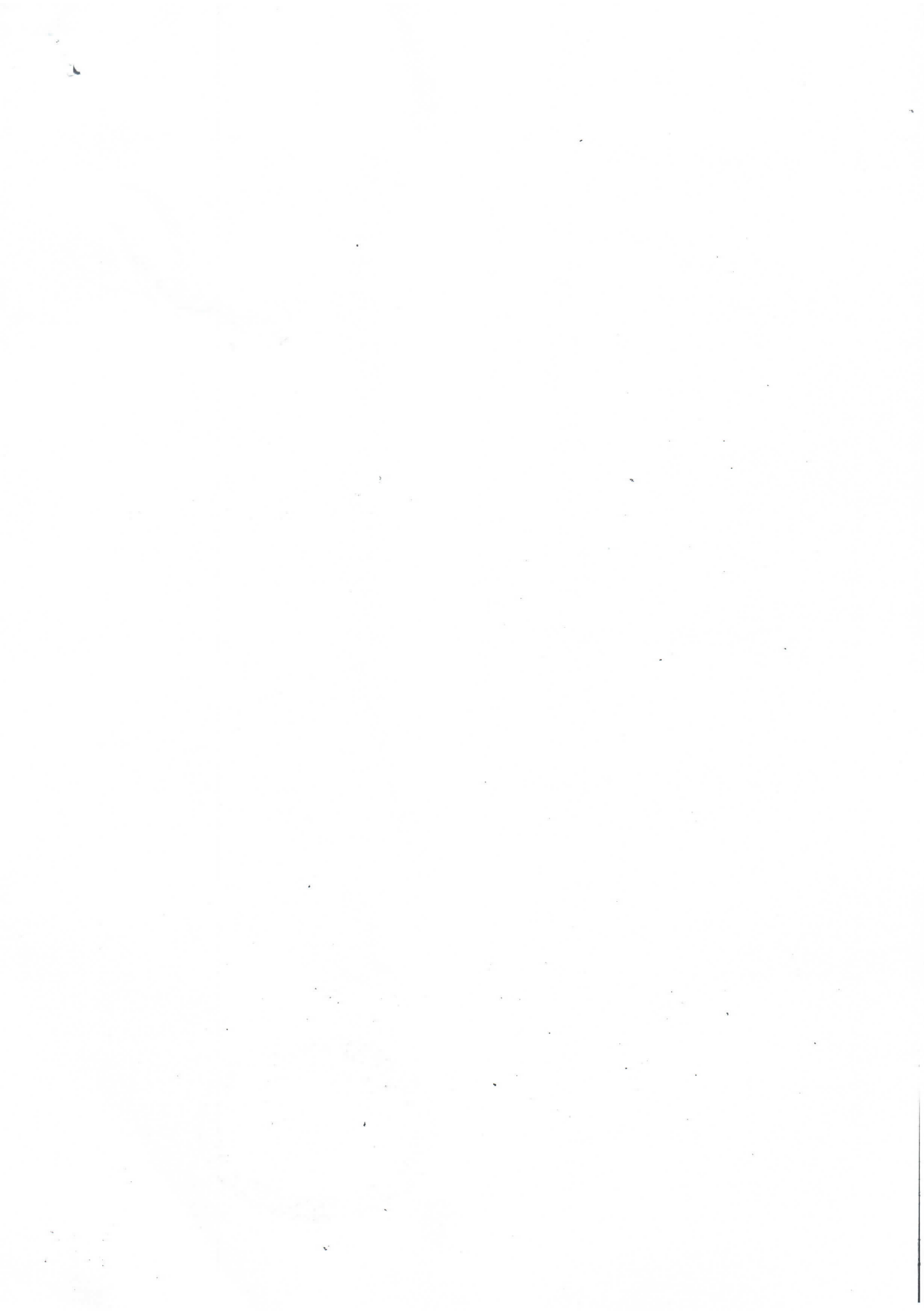
