Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction mostly one which is in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the Order bearing No.Dy.CTM/114(1)/2025-Dy.CTM(O&C) dated 19-09-2025 of the 3rd Respondent in placing the Petitioner under suspension in exercise of powers

under Rule 8 of A.P. Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1991 is illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and set aside the same. ✓

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed. praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to forthwith suspend the operation of Order bearing No.Dy.CTM/114(1)/2025-Dy.CTM(O&C) dated 19-09-2025 of the 3rd Respondent in placing the Petitioner under suspension, Pending disposal of WP 26587 of 2025, on the file of the High Court. ✓

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Smt. SODUM ANVESHA Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR Transport, Roads & Buildings Department for the Respondent No.1; Sri A. Rama Rao, Standing Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 & 3 and the Court made the following.

ORDER

“The present Writ Petition is filed questioning the Order of Suspension dated 19.09.2025 issued by the Respondent No.3 vide Proceedings No.DY.CTM/114(1)/2025-Dy.CTM (O&C). ✓

The Petitioner is working as Senior Assistant (Finance) in the A.P. Public Transport Department at Rajampet Depot. On the allegation that there are some financial irregularities noticed on verification of UPI transactions pertaining to the month of July, 2025, a Charge Memorandum was issued to the Petitioner on 19.09.2025, whereunder four charges were framed against the Petitioner. The Respondents passed the impugned Order of Suspension on the same day. ✓

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that in the preliminary inspection conducted by the Deputy Chief Accounts Officer, Kadapa Zone, it is contended that Sri Narayana, Junior Assistant (Finance), has been instructed orally by the Depot Manager to look after the oil bunk

transactions, and accordingly, he is attending day-to-day duties in addition to his normal duties and stated that he has no idea about the discrepancies in the UPA transactions.✓

Learned counsel further submits that the preliminary inspection itself was initiated at the instance of the petitioner, as apparent from the Chief Account Officer Order dated 08.08.2025. He further submits that on perusal of the said Preliminary Inspection Report, it does not attribute any foul play to the Petitioner.✓

Having heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner, on perusal of the Preliminary Inspection Report dated 08.08.2025 issued by the Deputy Chief Accounts Officer, it shows that it was the Petitioner who had red-flagged the irregularities on verification of the transactions in the Oil Depot in the month of July, 2025.✓

In the light of the Preliminary Inspector Report and the Respondents are directed to re examine the Order of Suspension in the light of the Preliminary Inspection Report, dated 08.08.2025 issued by the Deputy Chief Accounts Officer, Kadapa Zone within a period of two (2) weeks from today.✓
