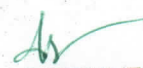
The Respondents are also permitted to levy the electricity charges against petitioner for supply of power without disconnection of the same, till the next date of hearing.

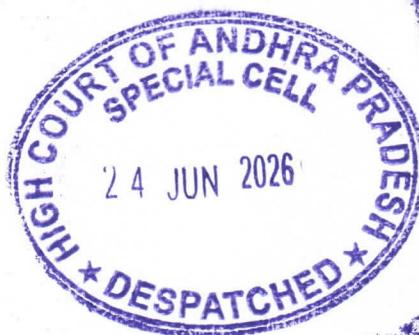
