Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased topleased to issue a writ, order, or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus or any other writ in not considering the case of the petitioner for reinstatement into service with continuity of service and appropriate relief by reconsidering the dismissal orders which also included the direction being treated the suspension period

from 23-05-2012 to 31-12-2012 as NOT ON DUTY in light of the honourable acquittal in C.C.No. 253 of 2014, in view of acquittal Judgment by the Hon'ble Judicial Magistrate of First Class/Special Mobile Court, Guntur, dt 17-12-2024 in CC.No.253 of 2014 by declaring the proceedings C.No.07/A7/OE- PR/2017, DO.No.822/2025, dt.30-06-2025 (orders served date 07-07-2025) issued by the 4th respondent dismissing the petitioner from service by procedure laid down in Rule 20 of ARCS (CC and A) Rules 1991, is arbitrary, illegal and in violation of Articles 14,16 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and to issue a consequential direction to the 3rd respondent to set aside the Dismissal order vide proceedings in C.NO.07/A7/OE-PR/2017 and to reinstate the petitioner into service with consequential benefits and to pass
