ORDER

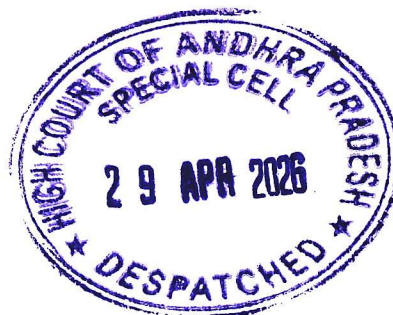
