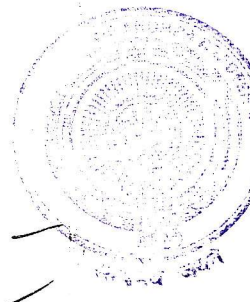

ORDER

Sri J.V.Siva Sai, learned counsel Sri Sreekanth Reddy Ambati, learned counsel appears for the respondent.

2. The appeal has been filed by the wife being aggrieved from the decree of divorce granted in favour of respondent.

3. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties are willing to resolve the dispute through process of mediation. They further submit that there are fair chances of amicable settlement.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the parties shall appear before the mediation and conciliation centre of this Court on 18.02.2026 which would be the first date. The subsequent dates for sessions shall be fixed by the mediation centre. The mediation centre through its mediators shall make endeavour to complete the proceedings within a period of three months from the date of first appearance of the parties, and submit the report to this Court.

6. Post after three (03) months from the date of first appearance along with the report of mediation centre.

7. Let the copy of this order be sent to the mediation centre of this Court with the particulars of this case.
