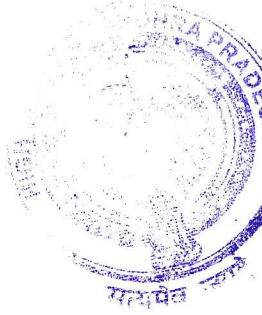

WHEREAS the Petitioner has presented under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971, above case through its counsel Sri V.Nitesh, praying that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to punish the respondents herein for willful violation and deliberate disobedience of the orders in W.P.No.19739 of 2024, dated 02.04.2025;

WHEREAS the said case coming on for orders as to admission on this day and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein and the earlier order of the High Court dated 19.11.2025 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.Nitesh, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Sri S.Bala Mohan Rao, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.1 & 6, and of Sri P.Vengala Reddy, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.2 to 5, and of M/s T.Lakshmi Padmaja, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.7 & 8, the Court made the following

ORDER:

The present Contempt Case is filed for willful disobedience on the part of the Respondents in implementing the Order dated 02.04.2025 in W.P.No.19739 of 2024 directing the Respondents to release the admitted amounts due to the Petitioner as per the agreement.

W.P.No.19739 of 2024 was disposed of on 02.04.2025 after taking note of the signed instructions of the Respondent No.3/ Commissioner.

Though four months' time is given to comply with the order, till date, the Respondent Authorities have not paid the admitted amounts due to the Petitioner.

As a last chance, the Respondent No. 3 is granted three weeks' time to comply with the Order; in default, the Respondent No. 3 shall appear before this Court by the next date of hearing.
