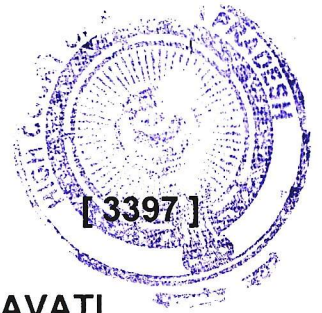

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all the proceedings in HMOP No. 131 of 2025 on the file of Hon'ble Civil Judge (Senior Division), Tadepalligudem, West Godavari District, Pending disposal of TRCMP No. 324 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The court, while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER

"Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the respondent is none other than the husband of the petitioner, and in view of the matrimonial disputes, the petitioner/wife has been residing separately along with her children, aged about 14 and 6 years respectively and is working as a physician in a local hospital at Kurnool to take care of her children.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would further contend that to cause inconvenience and to harass the petitioner/wife, the respondent/husband had filed H.M.O.P.No.131 of 2025 on the file of the Senior Civil Judge, Tadepalligudem, West Godavari District, under Section 13(1)(ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, seeking for dissolution of the marriage and the same is pending for adjudication.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would further contend that the petitioner /wife has been residing separately along with her children at Kurnool and the distance between Kurnool and Tadepalligudem is more than 450Kms, it is difficult for the petitioner/wife to travel to attend the divorce case proceedings which was filed by the respondent/ husband herein before the Court at Tadepalligudem on each and every adjournment without any male assistance and as such, the petitioner is constrained to file the present transfer petition.

Perused the record.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and for the reasons mentioned in the accompanying affidavit, there shall be an order of Interim Stay of all further proceedings

including appearance of the petitioner/wife i.e., respondent in H.M.O.P.No.131 of 2025 on the file of the Senior Civil Judge, Tadepalligudem, West Godavari District, till 28.11.2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry.”
