ORDER:

“The contention of the appellants is that they were unaware of filing of W.P.No.11848 of 2015 and that the vakalat filed on their behalf had been filed by forging their signatures in the vakalat.

In the light of such serious allegations, it would only be appropriate to stay the operation of the order of the learned Single Judge, dated 16.11.2022, till further orders.
