

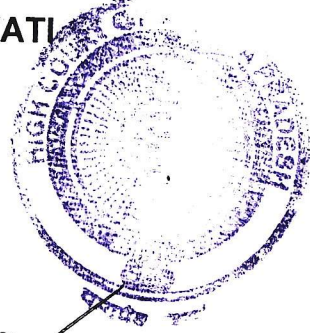

Department, dated 29.09.2025 issued by the 1st respondent Government and the Notification No. 241/SEC-B2/2025, dated 21.10.2025 issued by the 2nd respondent State Election Commissioner as contrary to law, illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of Natural justice and consequently set aside the same.
