

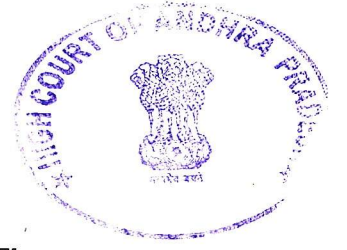

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the impugned order vide F.No.B3/6/ATP/2003 dated 15.10.2025 passed by

the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent notifying the same in A.P. Gazette W.No.43 in Part-II dated 23.10.2025 so far as appointing the 4th Respondent as Mutawalli to the Wakf institutions namely Hazrath Mastan Vali Dargah, Eidgah and Burial Ground and its attached properties in Sy.No.529-1 and 529-2 to an extent of Ac.8.67 cents covered by Shopping Complex located at Kothacheruvu Village and Mandal, Sri Satya Sai District, A.P. for a period of two (2) years for managing the affairs of the same under Section 63 of the Unified Waqf Management, Empowerment, Efficiency and Development Act, 1995 as amended by the Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025 (UWMEED Act) is being illegal, arbitrary, capricious, unconstitutional, in violation of provisions of the Wakf Act, 1995 and Regulations made therein and also in violation of Interim Orders passed by this Hon'ble Court in IANo.I of 2025 in W.P.No. 11255 of 2025 dated 06.05.2025 and Interim Order passed in I.A.No.I of 2025 in W.P.No.17016 of 2025 dated 11.07.2025.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of the impugned order vide F.No.B3/6/ATP/2003 dated 15.10.2025 passed by the 2nd Respondent notifying the same in A.P. Gazette W.No.43 in Part-II dated 23.10.2025 so far as appointing the 4th respondent as Mutawalli to the Wakf institutions namely Hazrath Mastan Vali Dargah, Eidgah & Burial Ground and its attached properties in Sy.No.529-1 & 529-2 to an extent of Ac.8.67 cents covered by Shopping Complex located at Kothacheruvu Village and Mandal, Sri Satya Sai District, A.P. for a period of two (2) years for managing the affairs of the same under Section 63 of the Unified Waqf Management, Empowerment, Efficiency and Development Act, 1995 as amended by the Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025 (UWMEED Act), Pending disposal of WP 29643 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier orders of the High court dated 10.03.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Masalegar Hidayathulla, Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Minority Welfare Respondent No.1 and of Sri Shaik Khaja Basha, Standing Counsel for Respondent Nos. 2 to 3 and the Court made the following;

**ORDER:**

“This Court, on 10.03.2026, directed the 2nd respondent to address on the complaint dated 02.02.2026 filed under Section 70 as contemplated under Section 71 of the Unified Waqf Management, Empowerment, Efficiency and Development Act, 1995, within a period of four (04) weeks from that date.

It is not in dispute that the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has not addressed the complaint in the said stipulated period.

In the said circumstances, this Court is inclined to issue notice to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in that regard and the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is directed to explain as to why suo moto contempt should not be initiated and file an affidavit before this Court in that regard within a period of two (02) weeks.
