The victim/de-facto complainant is impleaded as Respondent No.2 in this case as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court in <i>Jagjeet Singh and Others v. Ashish Mishra</i>¹. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on the victim and file proof to that effect. Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. The Petitioner is aged about 29 years, the victim is also aged about 29 years. They had for some time love affair, and they were in physical contact. Later Respondent No.2 became pregnant. The Petitioner allegedly had not kept his promise of marrying the de-facto complainant/victim. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the reason for Petitioner not marrying the de-facto complainant is that she is maintaining relationship with another man.
