The Court made the following:**ORDER:**

This instant Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, by the Petitioner/Accused, to grant anticipatory bail to him in the event of his arrest in connection with Crime No.88 of 2025 of Santhakviti Police Station, Vizianagaram District, for the offence punishable under Section 69 of BNS, 2023.

Heard Sri Mahesh Adavivarapu, learned counsel for the Petitioner, learned counsel for respondent No.2 and Ms.K.Priyanka Lakshmi, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent State. Perused the material on record.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner would submit that petitioner is working in Indian Army and respondent No.2 made the Petitioner as scapegoat and falsely implicated in this case by making unbelievable allegations against him and that if the entire allegations are taken at their face value, no case is made out against the Petitioner.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor on instructions would submit that there are allegations attributed against the Petitioner and that the matter is at the stage of crime and investigation is in progress and would submit that the Court may pass appropriate orders.

Considering the submissions and a fair look at the material on record, as rightly put by learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, the crime is under investigation and it is not the stage to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the Petitioner restricted the prayer and requested to grant liberty to the Petitioner to surrender before the concerned Trial Court and move regular bail Petition.

Considering the submissions made and taking into consideration of the request made by learned counsel for the Petitioner, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to surrender before the concerned Trial Court and move a regular bail petition before the concerned Trial Court. On filing of such bail petition, the concerned Magistrate is directed to pass appropriate orders according to law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two days.

Accordingly, this Criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall stands closed.
