10.	30.10.2025	<u>SV,J</u> <u>I.A.No.2 of 2023</u> <u>in</u> <u>A.S.No.522 of 2023</u> This petition is filed under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the C.P.C., seeking ad-interim injunction restraining the respondents 1 and 2 herein, their men, followers, agents, legal heirs etc., from ever interfering with peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners/appellants 2 to 5 herein over the suit schedule properties in O.S.No.05 of 2011 on the file of the I Additional District Judge, Chittoor. Heard S.S.Bhatt, learned counsel for the petitioners/appellants. Petitioners/appellants herein were the plaintiffs before the trial Court. The suit is filed for declaration and also for permanent injunction. During pendency of the suit, an interim injunction was granted and after hearing both the counsel, injunction was made absolute. Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that injunction was in their favour till the disposal of the suit, since first appeal is the continuation of the suit, the same order may be continued pending disposal of the appeal. 		Learned counsel for the respondent Nos.1 and 2 filed counter and submits that the original plaintiffs by name R. Ramakrishna Reddy and his wife are died and the other appellants are not the legal heirs. Thereby, they are not entitled them to grant injunction to this Court. However, there is an order of injunction right over from 2009 till date and there may not be any distinguished from the facts between A.S.No.522 and 523 of 2023. Considering the submissions made by the learned both the learned counsel and the issues raised in the appeal require detailed consideration, since appeal may take some time for disposal, it is appropriate to direct both parties to maintain <i>status quo</i> as it was there during the pendency of the suit.
