02.	27.12.2024	<u>BSB, J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2024</u> This application is filed to direct the respondents not to proceed further in laying the road by closing the natural water stream flowing from Periyavaram tank to Mogalagunta Village. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the natural water stream is being closed by using men and machinery and such high-handed action on part of the respondents cannot be resisted without passing any interim direction. The learned Assistant Government Pleader placed on record the written instructions of the 5th respondent, dated 27.12.2024, and submitted that the Deputy Executive Engineer, WRD, Venkatagiri, requested the Tahsildar, Venkatagiri Mandal for submission of a detailed survey report of Kalujukalava of Periyavaram Tank in Venkatagiri Mandal of Tirupati District and the survey report is awaited and after the receipt of the same, the report and the detailed facts would be submitted. A perusal of the written instructions reveals that	

		there is no denial of existence of the natural course of water flowing from Periyavaram tank to Mogalagunta Village as stated by the petitioners. Moreover, the respondents also are waiting for the survey report to proceed further. There is no specific denial of the action as alleged by the petitioners. Under these circumstances, interim relief as requested is granted, effective until 21.01.2025. B.S.BHANUMATHI,J <i>SCH</i>	
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
