Therefore, you viz;

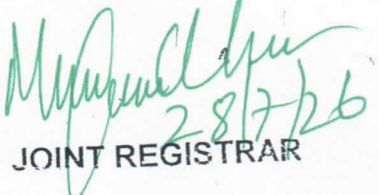
The Superintendent of Police, Tirupati, Tirupati District

You are further directed that if the said respondent furnishes personal bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each with an undertaking affidavit that he will appear before this Court on **20.08.2026**, he may be released on bail subject to the condition that he shall attend this Court on **20.08.2026** and shall continue to attend this Court until otherwise directed.

You are also further directed to return this warrant as early as possible preferably on or before **20.08.2026** to this Court with a detailed report stating the manner in which it has been executed.

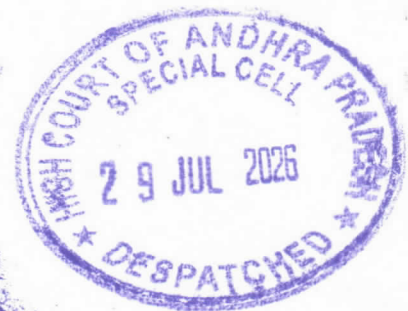

4. Learned counsel for the respondent states that the orders of this Court dated 25.06.2026 was informed to the respondent but he did not appear before this Court for the reasons best known to him. Hence, the action of the respondent herein is deliberate disobedience of the orders of this Court.

5. Hence, the Registry is directed to issue Bailable Warrant to respondent to be executed on or before 20.08.2026.
