Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus, to declaring the action of 4th Respondent-R.D.O., Ongole, who suspended the authorisation of the petitioner through his proceedings, dated 10-12-2024 in Rc.No.I/3499/2024, is wholly illegal, arbitrary and opposed to the spirit of Judgments of this Hon'ble High Court and without given opportunity to petitioner and also mandatory provisions of Control Orders and also violate of principals of natural justice and without jurisdiction and set-aside the proceedings of 4th Respondent-R.D.O., Ongole dt.10-12-2024 in
