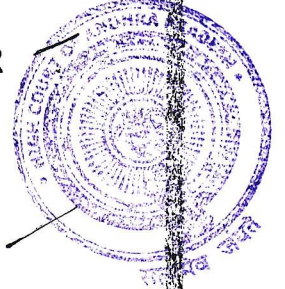

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declare the action of the respondents in not concluding long pending disciplinary proceedings vide G.O.Rt.No.165 Labour, Factories, Boilers and IMS (IMS and VIG) Department dated 11.05.2022 (incident pertaining to the year 2009), as per G.O.Ms.No.679 GA (SER.C) Department, dated 1-11-2008 and G.O.Ms.No.91 GAD Dated- 12-09-2022 in spite of orders passed in W.P.No.28832 of 2022 dated 25-10-2024 is illegal, arbitrary and against

the principles of natural justice and the inaction of the Respondents is against the spirit of judgment of the Honble Apex Court, reported in P.V.MAHADEVAN Vs. M.D. TAMIL NADU HOUSING BOARD and further, direct the Respondents to complete the disciplinary proceedings within 03 months, failing which the proceedings deemed to be quashed in and in terms of the similar orders passed in W.A.No.1072 of 2025 dated 07.10.2025;

IA NO: 1 OF 2025:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to conclude the disciplinary proceedings within 3 months, pending against the petitioner vide G.O.Rt.No.165 Labour, Factories, Boilers and IMS (IMS and VIG) Department dated 11.05.2022, pending disposal of WP.No.30497 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the High Court orders dated 11.11.2025, & 09.12.2025, made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Chilamkurthi Satya Dev Naidu, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri D. Vasmi Krishna, learned Assistant GP for Services II for the Respondents, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

Pursuant to earlier orders dated 11.11.2025 passed by this Court, a report is filed regarding Departmental Enquiries pending in various departments.

As per the report, a total of 5424 Departmental Enquiries are pending, and it does not disclose the date of initiation of the Departmental Enquiry and the stage of Departmental Enquiry.

Sri K. Rama Lingeswara Rao, Learned Government Pleader for Services would submit that the said data will be submitted by the next date of adjournment.

Considering the magnitude of the pendency of the enquiries, it would be appropriate for the Respondent(s)-Authorities to appraise this Court with regard to steps that are being taken for expeditious conclusion of the Disciplinary Proceedings in terms of G.O.Ms.No.91 General Administration (Ser.C) Department, dated 12.09.2022.

In that context, the Chief Secretary of the State Government is directed to appear virtually on 30.12.2025 at 2:15 PM.
