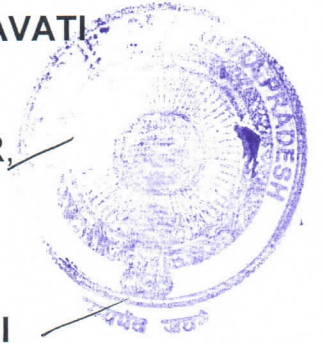

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to continue the petitioner as F.P. shop Dealer and to supply essential commodities to the petitioner's fair price shop at Kovaramguttapalli Village (Shop.No.1118031) of Simhadripuram Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, pending disposal of WP No. 30641 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P.Narahari Babu, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP for CIVIL SUPPLIES for Respondent Nos. 1 to 5,

The Court made the following

ORDER:

“This petition is filed to supply essential commodities to the petitioner’s fair price shop No.1118031, Kovaramguttapalli Village, Simhadripuram Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, pending disposal of the writ petition.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that without passing any order of suspension or cancellation of the dealership of the petitioner, in the show cause notice dated 16.12.2024 itself, a direction is given to make alternative arrangement for the supply of commodities for distribution to the cardholders.

In reply, the learned Assistant Government Pleader submitted that he had not received the written instruction, however he stated that the petitioner had not waited till submission of explanation to the show cause notice and filed the writ petition.

Therefore, he further stated that it is only the proposal and after MRO submits recommendations, an alternative arrangement would be made and therefore there is no foundation for the petitioner to seek the relief.

In reply, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that without following due procedure, even the proposal for arrangement cannot be ordered.

Considering the above submissions and instructions were not received by the learned Assistant Government Pleader, since the writ petition is adjourned and meanwhile to protect the interest of the petitioner, interim order as prayed for is granted.
