Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or orders or direction or a writ one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus directing the 3rd respondent herein to dispose the revision petition filed by 7th respondent vide Ref.No. E3/2261/2016 questioning the proceedings issued by the 4th respondent by an order dated 07-05-2016 vide D.Dis B/695/2015 within 3 months from the date of the order by duly declaring the inaction of the 6th respondent in interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner property in Survey No.554, an extent of 4.94 acres of Devamachupalli Village, Chitvel Mandal Chitvel, YSR (Kadapa) District as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violation of principles of natural justice and consequentially direct the respondent No.6 not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner property in Survey No.554, an extent of 4.94 acres of Devamachupalli Village, Chitvel Mandal Chitvel, YSR (Kadapa) District and pass
