Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 3rd Respondent in issuing Lr.No.EE/OD/MTM/dt.26.04.2025 vide Order, Adm/JAO/U2/D.No.559/2025, stopping the pension to the petitioner and directing to repay the entire family pension granted since the death of the husband of the petitioner, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 19 (1) (g), 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and set-

aside the same, consequently direct the respondents to release monthly pension as well arrears of the pension to the petitioner;

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to release monthly pension as well arrears of the pension to the petitioner, by suspending the Order, dt.26.04.2025 vide Lr.No.EE/OD/MTM/Adm/JAO/U2/D.No.559/2025, issued by the 3rd Respondent, Pending disposal of WP 32435 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition, coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri.AKULA VAMSI KRISHNA Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR ENERGY for the Respondent No.1, Sri.V.V.Satish, Standing counsel for R2 and R3 and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that, though the respondents released the family pension in the year 2021, surprisingly, now the impugned order has been passed without any reason, except stating that it was passed on the instructions of the Superintending Engineer, Operation, Vijayawada.

Considering the submissions and on perusal of the record, the impugned order dated 26.04.2025 passed by the 3rd respondent is suspended.
