Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ or direction more particularly a writ in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 3rd Respondent in passing the order in RoC.E1/e-office Computer no.281606/2020 dated 05-09-2020 and the order of the 2nd Respondent in Rc.E2/1052/2023 dated 15-06-2023 as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and against the provisions of Andhra Pradesh Dotted Lands (Updation in Re-settlement Register) Act, 2017 and the principles of natural justice and consequently set aside the same by directing the Respondents to incorporate the name of the Petitioner in revenue records pertaining to the land in Sy.No.156-2D-1A, admeasuring Ac. 0.535 cents of Pedda Eatipakam Village, Satyavedu Mandal, Tirupathi District.

IA NO: 2 OF 2023

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of order in Rc.E2/1052/2023 dated 15-06-2023 and order in RoC.E1/e-office Computer no.281606/2020 dated 05-09-2020 passed by the respondents 2 and 3 respectively, pending disposal of the Writ Petition No.31258 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 1 OF 2023

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to dispossess the Petitioner from the land in Sy.No.156-2D-1A, admeasuring Ac. 0.535 cents of Pedda Eatipakam Village, Satyavedu Mandal, Tirupati District, pending disposal of the Writ Petition No. 31258 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI.V.VINOD K REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Revenue for Respondents, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Today when the matter is coming up for instructions of learned Government Pleader for Revenue, he submitted that, a detailed counter is required to be filed in this matter and sought four weeks time for filing counter.

To the said submission, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, in the meantime, if the respondent authorities dispossess the petitioner from the subject land in view of the impugned orders, it not only affects the rights of the petitioner, but also purpose of filing the Writ Petition would be defeated. As such prayed to pass orders to protect the interest of the petitioner.

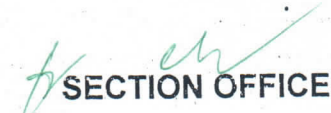
Taking the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner into consideration and in view of the circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to pass the following order.

Status quo shall be maintained by both parties with regard to the subject property for a period of eight weeks.
