The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent and proof of service shall be filed within a period of three (03) weeks from today. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this revision is filed against the order passed in E.P.No.106 of 2021 in O.S.No.410 of 2011 on the file of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurnool, dated 27.10.2025, ordering the arrest of the Judgment Debtor in civil prison for the period of three months from the date of execution of warrant. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that arrest warrant is not yet issued. Since the E.P. amount is Rs.11,16,619/-, the Judgment Debtor shall deposit Rs.4,00,000/- within a period of six (6) weeks from today. Subject to that condition of deposit, the further proceedings in E.P. are stayed pending further orders. In default, the stay granted by this Court automatically stands vacated.
