Petition under Section 115 of C.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed herein, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the order dated 27.10.2025 passed in E.P.No.106 of 2021 in O.S.No.410 of 2011 on the file of the Additional Senior Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurnool, whereby the Executing Court ordered the arrest and detention of the Petitioner/Judgment Debtor in civil prison for a period of three months;

Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of Order dated 27.10.2025 passed in E.P.No.106 of 2021 in O.S.No.410 of 2011 on the file of the Additional Senior Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurnool pending disposal of the Civil Revision Petition;

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. S V RUTHVIK, Advocate for the Petitioner;

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent and proof of service shall be filed within a period of three (03) weeks from today.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this revision is filed against the order passed in E.P.No.106 of 2021 in O.S.No.410 of 2011 on the file of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurnool, dated 27.10.2025, ordering the arrest of the Judgment Debtor in civil prison for the period of three months from the date of execution of warrant. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that arrest warrant is not yet issued.

Since the E.P. amount is Rs.11,16,619/-, the Judgment Debtor shall deposit Rs.4,00,000/- within a period of six (6) weeks from today. Subject to that condition of deposit, the further proceedings in E.P. are stayed pending further orders. In default, the stay granted by this Court automatically stands vacated.

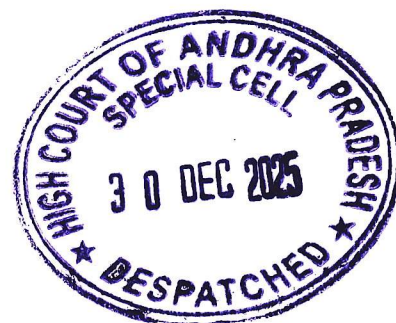
