AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri N.Ranga Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner and Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in memorandum of grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay and all further proceedings, including appearance of the petitioner/Accused Mo.6 in PRC No.20 of 2025 on the file of Judicial Magistrate of First Class Penukonda, in crime in FIR No. 18 of 2022 of Somandepalli Station, Ananthapuramu District, pending disposal of CRLP No.11934 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER:

Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner.

Issue notice to Respondent No.2.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

On perusal of the complaint lodged by the Respondent No.2 and the statement of him recorded by the Investigating Officer, there is no reference about the name of the Petitioner in the list of the persons who had allegedly instigated or threatened or advised the brother of Respondent No.2 (deceased) who took extreme step of ending his life by committing suicide.

There shall be stay of all further proceedings in PRC.No.20 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class Penukonda in

FIR.No.18/2022 of Somandepalli Station, Ananthapuramu District with regard to the Petitioner/Accused No.6 only.

For further hearing of the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, post after one week.
