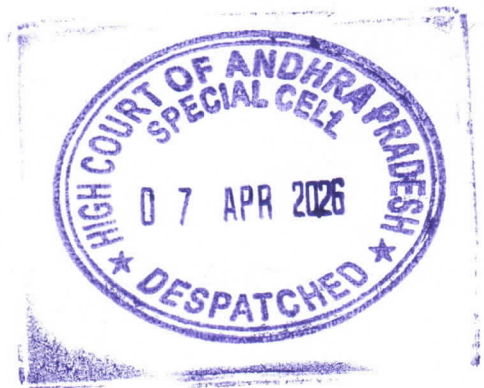

ORDER OF BAILABLE WARRANT

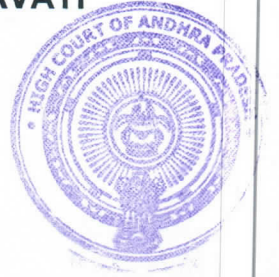

You are also further directed to return this warrant as early as possible preferably on or before 29.04.2026 to this Court with a detailed report stating the manner in which it has been executed.

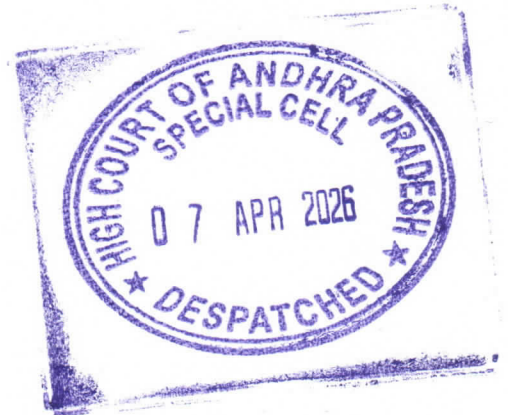
