The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 25.11.2025 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Gajjala Mallikarjuna Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner and Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1 and the Court made the following;

ORDER

Notice on 2nd respondent is served by the Station House Officer concerned.

No representation for the 2nd respondent.

Smt P.Padmavathi, learned counsel is appointed as legal aid counsel for the 2nd respondent.

The Secretary High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The petitioner herein, who is arrayed as Accused No.1, is the de-facto complainant in Crime No.261 of 2025 which was registered as some persons belonging to a political group vandalized the political party office of the petitioner.

The present case i.e., Crime No.260 of 2025 was lodged by 2nd respondent who is accused in Crime No.261 of 2025. Thus, there a case and counter case who are the aggressors and who are victim have to be decided by the investigating officer.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, gravity and nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, the investigating officer is directed to not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner, but the petitioner is cooperate with the investigating officer. The investigating officer may proceed with further investigation.
