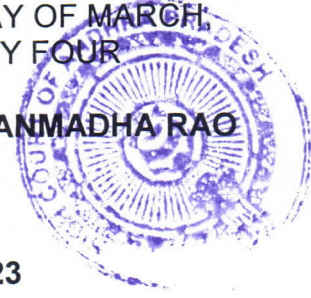

Petition under Order 41 Rule 5 of C.P.C., praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant Stay of all further proceedings including Execution in MVOP.No.264/2015 on the Court of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (Before the District Judge, Anantapuramu) dt:10-05-2018, pending disposal of MACMA No. 776 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER:

“There shall be interim stay of operation of the decree and judgment dated 10.05.2018 passed in MVOP No.264 of 2015 on the file of the Chairman,

Motor Accident Claims Tribunal-cum-District Judge, Ananthapuramu, subject to condition that the appellant deposits 50% of the awarded amount along with proportionate costs and interest to the credit of the above O.P. within a period of eight (08) weeks from today. On such deposit, the respondents/claimants are permitted to withdraw the deposited amount, as per their shares, in terms of the Award passed by the Tribunal, without furnishing any security."
