nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not enhancing the Petitioners age of superannuation from 60 years to 62 years who has been working as Executive Engineer in Respondent No.5 Corporation in terms of G.O.Ms.No.15 dated 31.01.2022, the subsequent Memo. No. AP Ordinance 01/B6/APHB/202 2 dated 27.09.2022 issued by the Respondent No.4 and the clarification given by Respondent No.3 vide Cir.Memo. No.1813129/FIN01- HR/212/2022-HR- IV dated 23.09.2022 which doesnot synchronize with G.O.Ms.No.15 dated 31.01.2022 or the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Regulation of Age of Superannuation) (Amendment) Act, 2022 as illegal, discriminatory , unjust, arbitrary, self-contradictory and is violative of Articles 14, 16, 21 and 23 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct all the Respondents to enhance the age of superannuation of Petitioner from 60 years to 62 years on par with the government employees in terms of G.O.Ms.No.15 dated 31.01.2022, without any break in service, with full back wages, all allowances and with all consequential benefits;

IA NO: 1 OF 2024:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased maybe pleased to pass an interim order by directing all the Respondent authorities to continue the services of the Petitioner upto the age of 62 years in the Respondent Nos.4 and 5 Corporations, pending disposal of WP.No.31574 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2024:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass an interim order by directing all the Respondent authorities to consider the written representation dated 27.12.2024 submitted by the Petitioner, pending disposal of WP.No.31574 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s CKR ASSOCIATES for the Petitioner and GP FOR GENERAL ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT for the Respondent No.1 and GP FOR MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION & URBAN DEVELOPMENT for the Respondent No.2 and GP FOR FINANCE for the Respondent No.3 and Sri Y.V.SRINIVASAN, Advocate for the Respondent No.4 and M/s PADMAJA GADIRAJU, STANDING COUNSEL for the Respondent No.5;

The Court made the following COMMON ORDER:

The learned Government Pleader for Services-I, on written instructions received from the Secretary to Government (HR), Finance Department, Andhra Pradesh, would submit that basing on the recommendations of the Group of Ministers, the file has been prepared and is under circulation for approval of the competent authority to place it before the Council of Ministers. As of now, the concerned file is with the Honourable Minister for Finance and is on its way for placing the proposal before the Council of Ministers as per the A.P. Business Rules. As per the resolution of the Council of Ministers, the Government will take action accordingly.

Basing on the instructions, learned Government Pleader sought four weeks time to take/complete appropriate action in the matter.

Considering the request of the learned Government Pleader, there shall be a direction to the respondents to place the action taken report by 2nd June, 2026 and submit the said report to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court on that day.

Post these matters along with W.A.No.1035 of 2025, to enable the Registrar (Judicial) to place the report before the Court, on 15.06.2026.

The instructions received and submitted by the learned Government Pleader shall form part of the record.
