be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, more particularly

one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents particularly 4th respondent trying to interfere with peaceful position and enjoyment of in respect of property i.e., house bearing no 7-243/7, in survey number 667/2B in an extent of AC. 0.06 cents in Vuyyuru Village and Mandal of Krishna district without issuing any notice illegal, arbitrary, and in violation of Article 14 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and against the violation of the principles of natural justice and against all settled principles of law and consequently direct the 4th Respondent not to interfere not to dispossession from the peaceful position and enjoyment of petitioner without issuing any notice and without following the procedure is established by law in house bearing no 7-243/7, in survey number 667/2B in an extent of AC. 0.06 cents in Vuyyuru Village and Mandal of Krishna District.

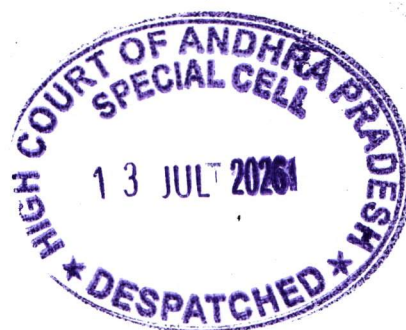
