Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of a writ of mandamus declaring the action of the 2nd Respondent in issuing proceedings vide D.Dis.No. 9746264/D11- ATP/2024 dated 04-08-2025 wherein determined the quarry lease held by the petitioner for Dolomite and Steatite in an extent of 4.083 hectares in Sy.No.1251- A, B, C, 431-3, 448-2 and 477 of Kristipadu Village, Peddavaduguru Mandal, Ananthapur District,

Andhra Pradesh, before passing appropriate orders by the revisional authority on the revision application dated 19-05-2025 filed by the petitioner against the Demand Notice No.1256/QL/2014, dated 04-02- 2022 of the 3rd Respondent is illegal, arbitrary, unjust, violation of Principles of natural Justice and violative of Art.14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same by directing the respondents to permit the petitioner to proceed with the quarrying operations in an extent of 4.083 hectares in Sy.No. 125-1, A, B,C C, 431-3, 448-2 and 477 of Kristipadu Village, Peddavaduguru Mandal, Ananthapur District subject to fulfillment of the orders passed by the Revisional authority on the revision petition dated 19-05-2025,
