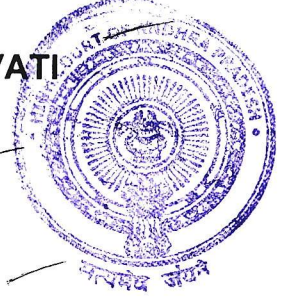

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate
KAMBHAMPATI RAMESH BABU presented this Petition under Article 226 of
the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the
affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate
order or direction more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS

declaring the inaction of Respondent No. 2 in not releasing the family pension and death benefits in view of the death of petitioners husband i.e. Thota Govindu, who was employed as a Public Health Worker (Sanitary Maistry) in Respondent No. 2 with ID/DEO Code 06151802001, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of principles of natural justice apart from being violative of Article 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct Respondent No. 2 to release the family pension and death benefits forthwith in the interest of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri KAMBHAMPATI RAMESH BABU Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Municipality for Respondent No.1, Sri Sireesha Vallabhaneni, standing counsel for R2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.5 and 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
