

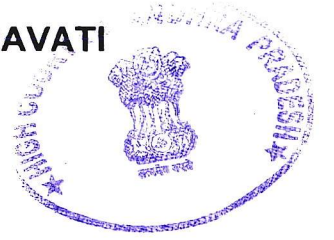

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus or Prohibition (a) Prohibit the Respondent Executive Officer from proceeding further in the Proceedings purportedly initiated under Section 83 (2) of the Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 pursuant to the Show-Cause Notice dated 04/12/2025 as being illegal, wholly without jurisdiction and consequently quash the proceedings (b) declaring the action of the Respondent Revenue Authorities in altering the Record of Rights (RoR) with name of the Respondent Sri Sangameswara Swamy Temple in respect of the Petitioner s land ad-measuring Ac.0.84 Cents situated in Sy.No.197/1 of Angalakuduru Village, Tenali Mandal, Guntur District without any proceedings, notice and affording an hearing to the Petitioner as illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14,19 and 300-Aof the Constitution and in blatant violation of the provisions contained in Andhra Pradesh Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Books Act, 1971 and consequently direct the Respondent Tahsildar to delete the name of Temple in the RoR and to forthwith re-enter the name of the Petitioner against the aforesaid land in the Record of Rights (c) declaring the entries made in Register Maintained under Section 43 of the A.RCharitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 with respect to the Petitioner s land ad-measuring Ac.0.84 Cents situated in Sy.No.197/1 of Angalakuduru Village, Tenali Mandal, Guntur District as illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 19 and 300-Aof the Constitution and in blatant violation of the provisions contained in Andhra Pradesh Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987 and consequently direct the Respondent Endowment Authorities to fourth with delete such entries in the Section 43 Register with respect to the Petitioners land. (d) declaring the action of the Respondent Sub-Registrar in including the Petitioners land ad-measuring Ac.0.84 Cents situated in Sy.No.197/1 of Angalakuduru Village,

Tenali Mandal, Guntur District in the Register Maintained under Section 22A of the Registration Act, 1908 as illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of natural justice and Articles 14, 19 and 300-A of the Constitution and in blatant violation of the provisions contained in the Registration Act, 1908 and consequently direct the Respondent Registrar to forthwith delete such illegal entries with respect to the Petitioners land in the Section 22A Register.
