Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in trying to dispossess the petitioners from their lands an extent of Ac.02-22 cents in Sy.No.76/2, Ac.O-30 cents in Sy.No.76/3 of the 1st petitioner and an extent of Ac.04 15 cents in Sy.No.76/14 and Ac.O-37 cents in Sy.No.80/7 of 2nd petitioner, situated at Adivimulakalapalle Village, Kuppam Mandal, Chittoor District, as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to law and violation of principles of natural justice apart from violation of Articles 19 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to dispossess the petitioners from their respective schedule properties i.e., an extent of Ac.02-22 cents in Sy.No.76/2, Ac.O-30 cents in Sy.No.76/3 of the 1st petitioner and an extent of Ac.04-45 cents in Sy.No.76/14 and Ac.O-37 cents in Sy.No.80/7 of 2nd petitioner, situated at Adivimulakalapalle Village, Kuppam Mandal, Chittoor District, and to pass
