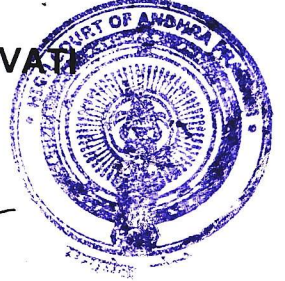

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri. KALLA TULASI DURGAMBA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring action of the respondents particularly 4th respondent impugned Endorsement dated 27.11.2025 issued by the Tahsildar, Jangareddigudem, vide PGRS Reference No. 515/2025(A), which wrongfully refuses to correct erroneous entries in the Web Land (Online Adangal) portal, Pattadar Record No. 375 of property is situated at Survey No. 170-2A, an extent of 2.04 cents situated in Tirumalapuram Village, Jangareddigudem Mandal, Eluru District, thereby depriving her of her recognized patta holder rights and violating under Petitioners constitutional and statutory rights under ROR Act and in violation of Article 14 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and against the violation of the principles of natural justice and against all settled principles of law and directing to Conduct a proper and complete enquiry into the wrongful Web Land entries and Examine the Pattadar Record (Document No. 375) as official documentary evidence and may direct to Issue a corrected Order directing the correction of Web Land portal to reflect applicants name as the sole patta holder of 2.04 cents and Direct the 2nd respondent / District Collector to immediately effect corrections within 30 days to enter the petitioners name and Maintain the applicants name in all future

land records as the rightful patta holder consequently setting aside the impugned Endorsement dated 27.11.2025 issued by the 4th respondent , as being Ultra vires the powers of the 4th respondent/Tahsildar In violation of principles of natural justice an abuse of discretionary power. Arbitrary, unreasonable, and perverse. Contrary to statutory law and the Constitution,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri KALLA TULASI DURGAMBA Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.6 & 7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
