The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of VENKATA DURGA RAO ANANTHA Advocate for the Petitioners, and of PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No 1, and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Since the alleged offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. Kalva Rama Thulasi, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services necessary Committee, is directed to issue proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator for amicable settlement.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, the presence of the Petitioners/Accused Nos. 1, 2 and 4 is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court unless it is otherwise required.
